Student Reflection: Elementary School

After watching the video about Peer Mediation, think about your answers to the questions below and share your answers with your classroom community.

- 1. A "peer" is someone who is about the same age as you. You can have peers in different places: at school, on sports teams, etc. Who are some of your peers? What do you like to do with your peers? Is your relationship with your peers similar to or different than your relationship with adults?

- 2. What does it mean to be "accusatory"? What word do you see in the word accusatory? How does it feel to be accused of something? Why?

- 3. What is one way that you show your friends that you respect them? Is name-calling respectful or disrespectful? Why?

- 4. When you have a problem with a friend, whom do you ask for help to solve your problem? How does that person help you?

- 5. What does it mean to resolve an argument? Describe a time that you had an argument with a friend. What was the argument about? How did you resolve the argument?
